

ERASMUS+ Programme Countries



Member States of the European Union

Non EU Programme Countries: Republic of North Macedonia, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Serbia.



ERASMUS+ Student Exchange



Mobility activity has to be compatible with the student's degreerelated learning and personal development needs.

Students may carry out either one or a combination of the activities described below:

- □ study period abroad at a partner higher education institution (HEI).
- □ combination of studies and traineeship: either one activity after the other or both at the same time.
- □ traineeship (work placement) abroad in an enterprise or any other relevant workplace. This includes Digital Opportunity Traineeships for students and recent graduates to develop or acquire digital skills.



Advantages of Exchange

- ERASMUS+ studies and/or traineeship* is a fully recognised part of your diploma/degree.
- Studies at KTU are not terminated.
- Financial support is available.
- Scholarships/payments from KTU remain.
- No age limit.
- ERASMUS+ is open to students with special needs (additional support available).

Duration of the Exchange Activities



Study mobility: from 3 to 12 months

Traineeship mobility: from 2 to 12 months

The same student may participate in mobility periods totalling **up to 12 months maximum per each cycle of study**, independently of the number and type of mobility activities.

Forms of Exchange



Study and Traineeship Activities can be either **physical**, **virtual** or **blended**.

Physical exchange = on site in the host country

Blended exchange combines a period of online studies/traineeship with a period of physical stay in the host country.

For the **physical part** of blended exchange, a minimum duration of **3 months** (studies) or **2 months** (traineeship) apply.

Virtual exchange* is carried out exclusively online, without the physical presence of students in a host country. Virtual exchange is meant an online activity taking place in the home country.

*In the context of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Funding Options



- ✓ Once the **physical** mobility period starts in the host country, students can get the regular grant for the period abroad.
- ✓ Grant is allocated only for the physical part of the blended mobility.
- ✓ Students cannot receive a grant during the period of **virtual** activities <u>in their</u> <u>country of residence</u> as they should be able to pursue those activities without additional costs.

Inclusiveness & Special Needs Support



Special needs support*

For people with mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities and health-related conditions;

*A contribution is based on real costs.

Special conditions (support of 200 EUR/month)

Student Mobility for Studies



- Following <u>courses</u> at a higher education institution
- Recognition of learning outcomes/credits
- KTU must have inter-institutional agreements with the receiving partner universities before the mobility for studies takes place.
- In case of blended student mobility the activities may include participation in courses offered in a blended learning format at any partner HEI.

Recent Graduates/ Post Docs



- Application (during last year of studies/ 1 day before disertation defence)
- Traineeship period (within 12 mons. after studies/ disertation defence)
- **Funding** (recent graduate traineeship is supported for a maximum of 12 mons. period per study cycle)
- More than one traineeship is possible until the limit of 12 mons is reached

Selection for exchange STUDIES:

Twice a year (September and March)

Selection for TRAINEESHIPS:

Four times a year (September, December, March, June)





Novelties of ERASMUS+ Student Mobility



- Long term mobility: from 2 to 12 months for studies (including a complementary traineeship period, if planned)
- Short-term physical mobility (as part of blended mobility)
- Doctoral short-term mobility: from 5 to 30 days (physical)
- Blended intensive programmes
- Additional support for students with fewer opportunities
- Support for green travel

Blended Intensive Programmes



Blended mobility curricula and activities for students jointly developed by a group of higher education institutions:

- At least three higher education institutions from 3 Programme countries
- Minimum number of participants:15
- Duration of physical mobility: from 5 to 30 days
- Combined with a compulsory virtual component (collaborative online learning exchange and teamwork), duration of virtual component is not limited.

Students with Fewer Opportunities



- Participants with physical, mental and health related conditions
- Students with children
- Students who work
- Professional athletes
- Students from all study fields underrepresented in mobility

Students and recent graduates with fewer opportunities receive **a top-up amount** to the individual support. The criteria to be applied are defined at national level by the National Agency.

Individual Support for Green Travel



Green travel is defined as the travel that uses low-emissions means of transport for the main part of the travel, such as bus, train or car-pooling.



In this case, exchange students and recent graduates will receive a single contribution as a top-up amount to the individual support and up to 4 days of additional individual support to cover travel days for a return trip, if relevant.
