



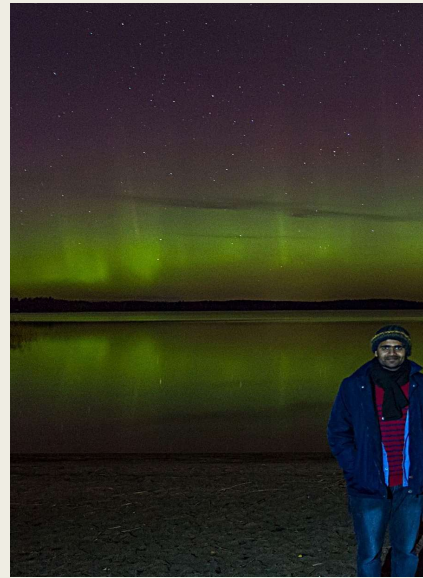

- Sent an empty/plain email requesting an internship opportunity.



- Sent an email with requesting an internship opportunity with CV, motivation letter, cover letter. **Not enough**

- Sent an email with requesting an internship opportunity with CV, motivation letter, cover letter **Articles, files, pictures, even screenshots of your work in the email.**



- Mention you are looking for **Voluntary** internship, **Unpaid** internship, **Erasmus** traineeship. **Email subject or First line in the cover letter**



- Don't forget to apply in startups and university research projects.

# You got selected! Now what?

- Work hard and efficient.
- Be punctual, polite and efficient.
- Make sure your contribution is recognized.
- Socialize.
- Try out their culture.
- Try blending in.



# You finished your traineeship. So?

- Create a network for yourself.
