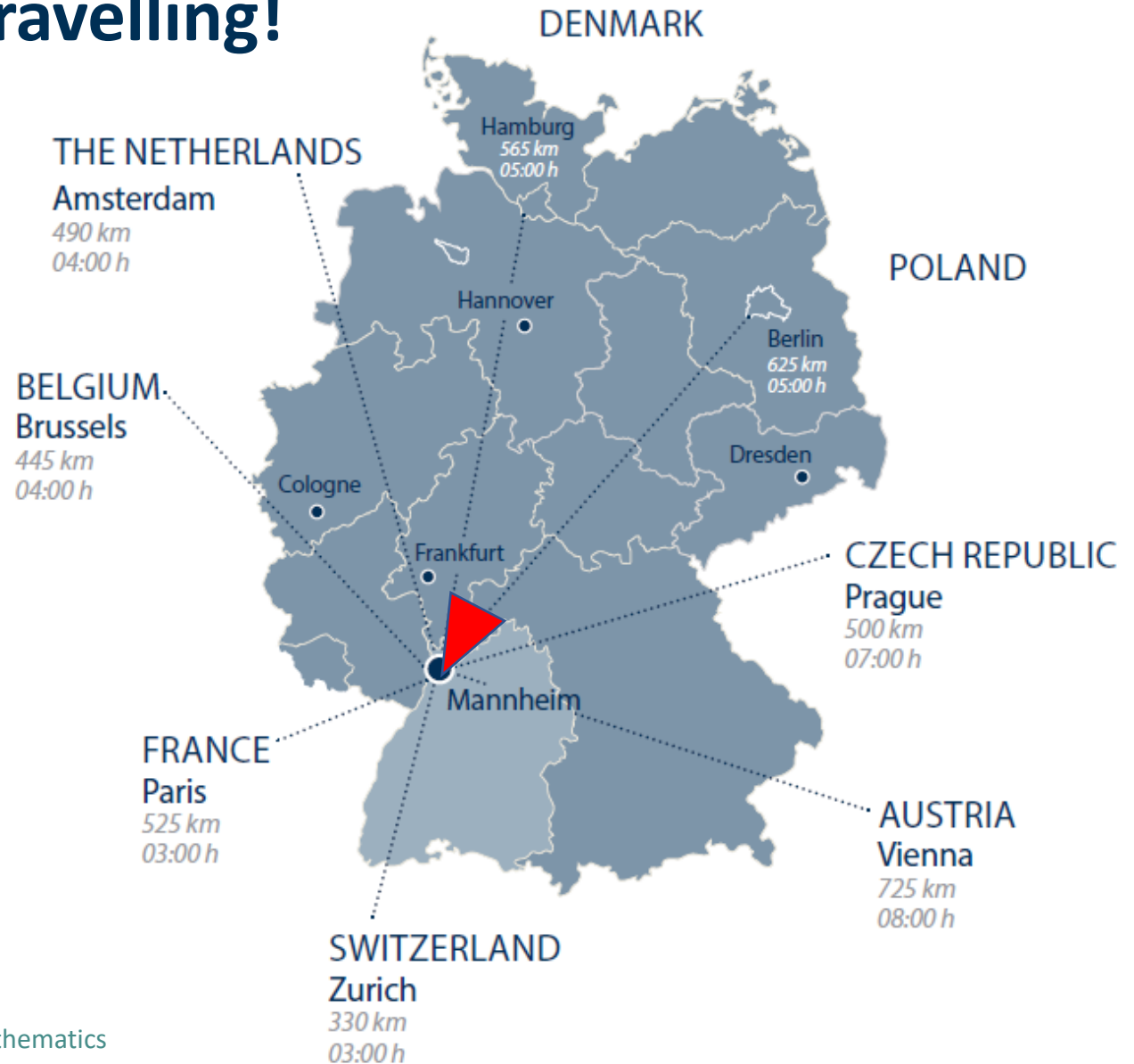


Small but mighty

- We offer interdisciplinary teaching, excellent research and a close contact to multinational companies.

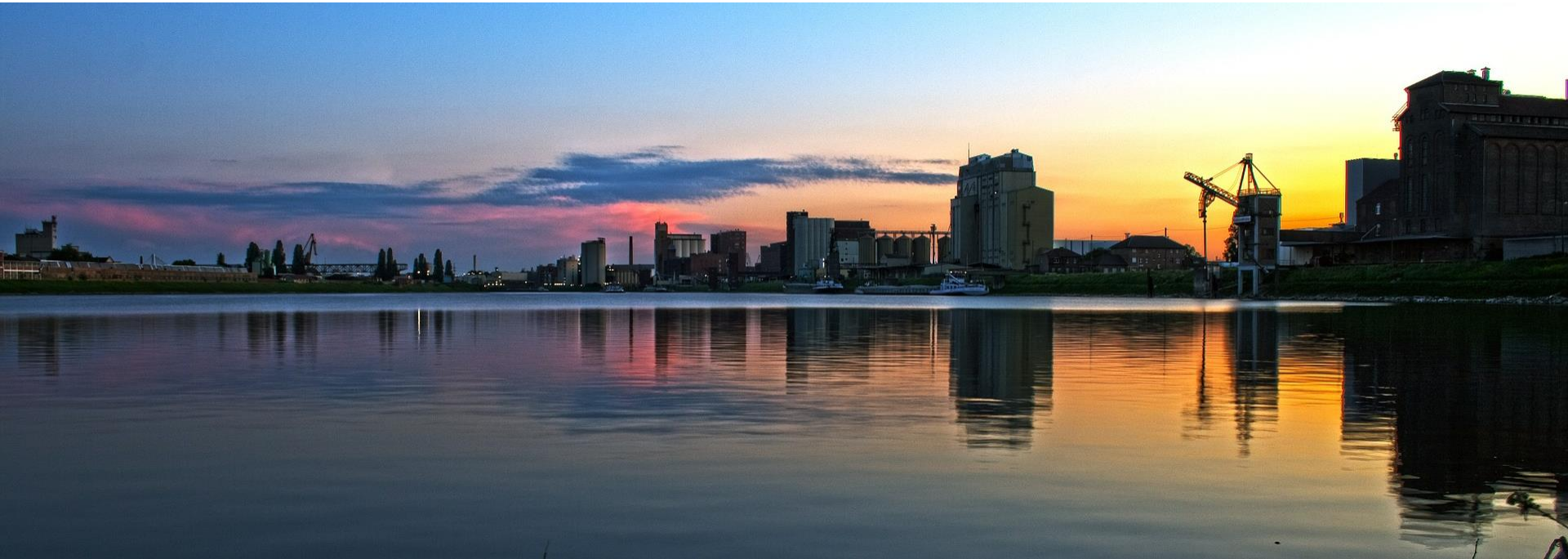
